

VIOLIN AUDITION

Solo

First movement exposition of any standard Classical or Romantic period concerto (Examples: Beethoven, Bruch, Glasunov, Mendelssohn, Mozart, Sibelius, or Tchaikovsky)

Excerpts

MOZART

Symphony No. $39 - 2^{nd}$ mvt: mm. 1 - 27 (no repeat); and 4^{th} mvt: mm. 1 - 41

BRAHMS

Symphony No. 4 – 4th mvt: mm. 33 – 80

BEETHOVEN

Symphony No. 7 – 1st mvt: mm. 70 – 130

BARTOK

Concerto for Orchestra – 5th mvt: mm. 265 – 317 (Violin 2)



VIOLA AUDITION

Solo

First movement exposition of any standard concerto (such as Bartok, Hindemith, Walton, Hoffmeister or Stamitz).

Excerpts

BERLIOZ Roman Carnival Overture - One mea. after [1] to 8 mea. after [3]

BEETHOVEN Symphony No. $5-2^{nd}$ mvt: mm. 1-10; and mm. 72-86

MENDELSSOHN Midsummer Night's Dream - Scherzo: Beginning to [D]

MOZART *Symphony No. 35* – 4th mvt: mm. 134 - 181



CELLO AUDITION

Solo

First movement exposition of any standard concerto (Examples: Block, Dvorak, Elgar, Haydn, Schumann, Shostakovich, or Walton)

Excerpts

BEETHOVEN

Symphony No. 5 – 2nd mvt: beginning to rehearsal [D]

BRAHMS

Symphony No. 2 – 2nd mvt: beginning to rehearsal [A]

MOZART

Symphony No. 35 - Finale: mm. 134 - 181

TCHAIKOVSKY

Symphony No. $4 - 2^{nd}$ mvt: mm. 21 - 41

DEBUSSY

La Mer - 2 mea. before [9] to 6 mea. after [9]



BASS AUDITION

Solo

Exposition from first movement of major concerto of choice (Dragonetti, Dittersdorf, Vanhall, Koussevitzky, Bottesini)

Excerpts

BEETHOVEN Symphony No. 5 – 3rd mvt: mm. 1-100 and pickup to mm. 141-218 (no repeat)

BRAHMS Symphony No. 2 – 1st mvt: [E] through the first bar of [F] (mm. 118-156)

MAHLER Symphony No. $1 - 3^{rd}$ mvt: Bass solo (m. 3-10)

MOZART Symphony No. 40 – 1st mvt; mm. 114 -134
